

## Senior Trip 2011 FAQs

**Q: What will the schedule be for the trip?**

**A:** Check-in begins at 11:30 am on Thursday, June 2 at MPHS parking lot. Please bring your ID and your MPHS issued Disneyland ticket for Check-in. We will go to California on chartered buses, stopping a couple of times along the way for meals/restroom breaks and to change clothes prior to going into Disneyland. (Please make sure your clothing meets the Disneyland rules because you will not be admitted into the park with the wrong clothing on). You can wear comfy, but not revealing, clothes on the bus for traveling. The actual Grad Nite in Disneyland will start at 8 pm and you will get access to the park, Blast Off party and a meal voucher is included. At 6 am on Friday, June 3, we will board the buses to return home to the MPHS Parking lot. We will stop along the way for food and restroom breaks and return to MPHS at approximately 2 PM on June 3<sup>rd</sup>.

**Q: How can I get tickets for the Senior Trip?**

**A:** Come to the Grad Nite table at lunch on Tuesdays or Thursdays or visit [www.mphsprideboosters.com](http://www.mphsprideboosters.com) (click on Grad Nite tab) for the necessary paperwork. Bring it back completed along with payment up until 4/29/11. We need to have time to make sure we get payment to Disneyland and the tickets sent to us before we leave. Disneyland requires payment no later than 30 days prior to the event.

**Q: Who will be going?**

**A:** Many 2011 graduates of MPHS will be going. Many other schools will be attending as well (lots from California). MPHS Parents and Staff Members will be the chaperones. Since this is held at night, only the students and their chaperones will be at Disneyland.

**Q: What is the cost?**

**A:** Tickets are on sale for \$100. You must also buy a 2011 Grad Nite ticket and attend the Castles N Coasters Event. The \$100 price includes admission to Disneyland, admission to Blast Off, which is in California Adventure, a meal voucher for Blast Off area and Transportation to/from Disneyland. You must bring your own spending money for meals (both in transit and at the park) and for any other incidentals you may wish to purchase, including mementos at Disneyland. We are not anticipating any further additional costs at this time, but we reserve the right to increase the price, depending upon the number of students who sign up and how many buses are required.

**Q: What else do I need to know?**

**A:** Disneyland has lots of rules about what you can wear and what you can bring into the park. Be sure to review this on the packet you print from the website or that you pick-up at the Grad Nite table at lunch. Let us know if your cell phone number or e-mail address change after you have completed your paperwork so we can keep you informed.


*Disneyland*® Grad Nite is a drug, alcohol, and weapon-free event. Anaheim Law Enforcement will be present during the event and will take appropriate actions if drugs, alcohol, drug paraphernalia or weapons are found.

### Prepare for the Magic – Prior to Arrival

- If you have any questions regarding Grad Nite prior to your Grad Nite event, please contact your Grad Nite Chairperson and they will contact the *Disneyland*® Grad Nite Office.
- On the day of your Grad Nite event, only take with you the things you really need and leave every thing else at home.
- Double check to make sure you are following the Dress Code Guidelines and Prohibited Items List (see pages 18-19). Anyone not adhering to the *Disneyland*® Resort Dress Code Guidelines or Prohibited Items List will be delayed and/or denied admission to the event.
- If you have any prescription medication that you will need during the event, please inform your Grad Nite Chairperson in advance to receive further information. You will need to give your prescription medication to your Chaperone for safekeeping during the event (excluding asthma inhalers, epi-pens and insulin). **All medication will be inspected at the event.**

### Enter the Magic - Upon Arrival

- Students are **NOT** allowed to arrive in Student-driven vehicles to the event.
- Please have your *Disneyland*® Grad Nite admission ticket ready as you enter the turnstiles and keep your tickets in a safe place!
- Get ready for a pat down process and security bag check.
- As you go through the turnstiles, please look for your commemorative event maps. The maps will provide dining options, merchandise locations, and entertainment information.



# Disney GRAD NITE

## Enjoy the Magic – During the Event

- **Students attending Disneyland® Grad Nite have a responsibility to:**
  - o Treat others with respect and honesty.
  - o Conduct themselves in a manner which will not interfere with other Guests.
  - o Follow the Dress Code Guidelines and Prohibited Items List (see pages 18-19) and remain in approved attire throughout the night.
  - o Report any hazardous or dangerous situations to any adult Chaperone, Disney Cast Member, or official authorities.
- **Students must not:**
  - o Possess or distribute any material prohibited such as drugs, drug paraphernalia, alcohol, weapons or any gang-related items.
  - o Fight or engage in horseplay.
  - o Harass others for any reason.
  - o Chant school names.
- *Disneyland®* Grad Nite is a **non-smoking** event. No one, regardless of age, will be allowed to smoke at any time during the event inside the Parks.
- If you need to contact one of your Chaperones during Grad Nite, please see a Disney Cast Member at Chaperone Headquarters located at the *Disneyland®* Opera House on Main Street, U.S.A. and your Chaperone will be called.
- Enjoy all the fun! *Grad Nite Explosion!* fireworks show, hottest dance clubs, world-class attractions, meet & greet Disney Characters, exclusive Grad Nite merchandise, *Disney's PhotoPass®* Service, and much more!
- If you lose items on the night of your Grad Nite, check with a Disney Cast Member at the Chaperone Headquarters (*Disneyland®* Opera House). If following your Grad Nite event you realize items were lost or left in a locker, please contact Lost & Found at (714) 817-2166.

## Dress Code Guidelines

Dress code guidelines have always been a part of Grad Nite at the *Disneyland*® Resort. Ties, jackets, skirts and heels were once the mainstay of the Grad Nite experience; however, over the years the dress code has evolved to keep up with the current fashion and trends and to make everyone more comfortable to enjoy this great celebration.

The dress code and prohibited items list have been established to ensure a safe event for Students and Chaperones. It is ultimately the school's responsibility to ensure that all Students and Chaperones adhere to the Grad Nite dress code upon arrival.

Please note some individual schools' dress code policies may be stricter than that of the *Disneyland*® Resort.

**We highly suggest** that all schools/organizations should conduct their own Security and Dress Code screening prior to departure and arrival at the *Disneyland*® Resort for faster and smoother processing once at the Main Entrance.

Please refer to the dress code guidelines and prohibited items list on the next page.

### Things to remember:

- It is ultimately the school's responsibility to ensure that all Students and Chaperones adhere to the Grad Nite dress code.
- Failure to follow the dress code may result in delayed admission and/or denial of admission to the Grad Nite event.
- *Disneyland*® Resort Security has the right to refuse admission to anyone they deem inappropriately dressed for the event.
- All apparel must be in good condition (excessively ripped or torn jeans, shirts, etc. are prohibited) and extremely revealing clothing is not allowed.

# Grad Nite – Prohibited Items

What to wear? What to bring? Here's a list to help you out!

**This list applies to all Guests (Students and Chaperones)**

## Prohibited Items

## Common Items that Are Allowed

### Prohibited Controlled Substances/Medication

- Alcohol and any controlled substance
- Non-prescription medication (aspirin, vitamins, etc)
- Contact solution, eye drops, hand sanitizers, larger than 4 oz. (120mL)
- Tobacco products (cigarettes, cigars, chew, etc.)
- Tobacco related item

### Allowed Controlled Substances/Medication (all items will be inspected at Nurse's Station)

- Asthma inhalers
- Cough drops
- Contact solution, eye drops, hand sanitizers smaller than 4 oz (120mL)
- Epinephrine (Epi Pens)
- Insulin/Syringes

### Prohibited Food & Beverage

- All food (candy, gum, mints, chips, etc)
- All fluids (water, drinks, perfume, cologne, lotion, etc.)
- Glass containers

### Allowed Make-Up and Toiletries

- Eye-liner pencils
- Chapstick and/or lip gloss (in non-glass containers)
- Make-up in non-glass containers
- Compacts with small mirrors
- Deodorant (Stick or gel only, cans are not allowed)

### Prohibited Apparel

- Spike jewelry (earrings/belts)
- Shoes with skate wheels
- Bags/Backpacks larger than 8.5" x 11"
- Apparel with logos larger than the size of your fist
- Head wear, do-rags, hats, bandanas
- Clothing affiliated with schools, sports team, clubs
- Jerseys
- Letterman jackets
- Costumes
- Custom/Homemade T-shirts (i.e. Class of 2001)

### Allowed Apparel

- Dull/rounded spikes
- Flip flops/Sandals/Boots (will ask to be removed for inspection)
- Purses, bags, backpacks smaller than 8.5" x 11"
- Chaperones with bag tags are exempt.
- Apparel with logos smaller than the size of your fist
- Licensed Disney hats
- Shorts
- Religious and traditional headwear (Yamakas/Turbans)

### Prohibited Miscellaneous Items

- Weapons
- Markers/Sharpies
- Pens
- Pencils
- Laser pointers
- Aerosol Cans

### Allowed Miscellaneous Items

- iPods
- Cell Phones
- Small Cameras (size of your hand)
- Pin Lanyards
- Blankets
- Umbrellas
- Playing Cards
- Glow Items (sticks, necklaces, bracelets)

In order to maintain this fun and safe atmosphere, we have the following list of prohibited items. We ask your help as parents and guardians to insure none of these items are brought to Disneyland. If you have any questions regarding Grad Nite, please contact the Grad Nite Chairperson of your school or organization. Please complete and return this form to your Grad Nite Chairperson. Thank you!

My student (listed below) will be attending Grad Nite at the *Disneyland®* Resort. I understand that certain rules and regulations will be in effect during Grad Nite, as listed hereinbelow, and I agree to advise my student of such rules and regulations prior to Grad Nite. I also acknowledge and agree that in the event my student violates any of such rules or regulations, my student will be required to exit the *Disneyland®* Resort and I agree to be responsible for picking up my student at the *Disneyland®* Resort.

Grad Nite Rules and Regulations:

The following items are **PROHIBITED** (All students will be searched prior to entering the *Disneyland®* Resort). For a complete listing of the Dress Code Guidelines and Prohibit Items, please visit [www.disneylandgradnite.com](http://www.disneylandgradnite.com):

1. Alcohol and drugs (controlled substances)
2. Tobacco products (cigarettes, cigars, chew, etc.) and related items (lighters, matches, etc.)
3. Any non-prescription medication including aspirin and vitamins
4. Contact solution, eye drops, hand sanitizers larger than 4 oz. (120mL)
5. Any type of weapon, aerosol cans, markers, sharpies, pens, pencils, or laser pointers
6. All fluids of any kind, including water, drinks, perfume, cologne, lotions, etc.
7. All food including candy, gum, mints, chips, etc.
8. Glass containers of any kind such as perfume jars, cologne, etc.
9. Any clothing affiliated with a school, sports team, clubs, etc.
10. Apparel with logos larger than the size of your fist
11. Custom/homemade t-shirts (i.e. Class of 2011)
12. Any shoes with skate wheels on them
13. Head wear such as hats, do-rags, bandanas, etc.
14. Spiked jewelry or belts
15. Bags and backpacks (All purses/bags must be smaller than 8 ½" x 11")

# Disneyland Senior Trip 2011

## Agreement & Consent Contract

I understand that only 2011 graduates of Mountain Pointe High School ("MPHS") who have purchased tickets by April 29, 2011 AND purchased tickets (and attended) for the 2011 Grad Nite event at Castles N Coasters will be allowed to travel on the chartered buses to Disneyland. Graduates will meet at 11:30 am on Thursday, June 2<sup>nd</sup> at MPHS parking lot (Buses will leave promptly at 12 pm (noon)) and travel by bus to Anaheim, CA; they will return at approximately 2 pm on Friday, June 3<sup>rd</sup>. The graduates will be chaperoned by MPHS parents and staff members. FINAL DETAILS WILL BE COMMUNICATED BY E-MAIL. Please insure that both parent and student e-mail addresses are included below.

The ticket price for the Senior Trip has initially been set at \$100; the final price is dependent on the number of participants and transportation costs. Tickets will be sold during both lunches on Tuesdays and Thursdays, beginning March 22 through April 29, 2011. Tickets will also be sold during panoramic pictures. There may be additional cost, not to exceed \$25, which will be collected from participants after April 29, 2011. Participants will need to bring their own spending money for travel meals (2) and for meals/souvenirs at Disneyland. One meal voucher at Disneyland is included in the price of the ticket.

Students whose parents have already contributed to Senior Class Council via Tax Credit Donations should also complete this agreement form. ALL DISNEYLAND PARTICIPANTS WILL STILL NEED TO BRING MEAL AND SPENDING MONEY AS MENTIONED ABOVE AND MUST HAVE PURCHASED A TICKET AND ATTENDED GRAD NITE '11 EVENT AT CASTLES N COASTERS.

### Parent/Guardian & Student Contract (must accompany payment)

I have read the information about the 2011 Senior Trip to Disneyland on June 2 and June 3<sup>rd</sup>. I have read and understand the rules on the pages titled Disneyland Grad Nite Student Information (with page #16-19 in lower right corner), including the Prohibited Items Chart. Participants who violate the dress code will not be allowed to board the buses or be admitted to Disneyland. Any prohibited items will be confiscated at check-in at MPHS. I understand that this event is NOT a school sponsored event. The Senior Trip 2011 is a drug-free/alcohol free event.

I hereby release the Grad Nite Committee, MPHS Pride Board, and the officers and volunteers from any and all liability for injury or illness while the below named Student is a participant at the 2011 Disneyland Senior Trip. I understand that the Student must ride the school chartered buses to Disneyland from the MPHS parking lot and return on the chartered buses to the MPHS parking lot, without prior written approval by parents and MPHS Grad Nite. Students not returning to MPHS via the chartered buses will only be released to their parents at Disneyland and parents must sign an affidavit that they have received their student.
