

Mountain Pointe High School Pride Booster Board
Minutes of the January 19, 2011 Meeting

- Meeting called to order at 6:00 PM by President, Lara Ketterman.
- Lara passed around the “yearbook” that Swim and Dive completes each year. They make about \$1,500 from the book.
- Several new faces were in attendance so each person introduced themselves to the group.

- Approval of minutes from December 2010 Meeting—Motion by Dee Davies, to accept the minutes of the December 15, 2010 meeting. Seconded by Mike McCloskey. Motion passed.
- Administration Report by Patricia Goolsby, Vice Principal:
 - Defibrillator: District got involved and asked us to hold off until they completed some research. The Defibrillators were the District project and each school received 2. Some worry that if Pride Board purchases the third unit for MPHS, then the District may have other schools ask for a third unit and they are not in the budget. So we tabled the Defibrillator discussion until Mrs. Goolsby informs us otherwise.
 - Open House Monday 1/24/11. Lots of groups have requested tables so there are no more tables available. The Coin Van will be on site supporting Grad Nite '11 so bring your coins to the Open House event.
 - Softball Bocce Ball Tournament will be held 2/5/11. Team sign up forms are available in the front office.
 - MPHS now has a Robotics Team. ITT Tech has contributed \$5,000 and various tools were donated by parents and community members. There are 10-15 students involved and there is a Competition Team. This Robotics Team has been 3 years in the making and it is finally a reality.
 - MPHS will be hosting Em-Power Town (a mini Anytown). The event will be held on 1/27/11. Discussions will focus on bullying, race discrimination and other forms of discrimination. “We are more alike than we are different” is the theme. MPHS was formed to take in 5 different feeder schools and we are a family of lions, thus the mascot “The Pride”. Em-Power Town is looking for primarily sophomores and juniors to be involved but will accept some seniors for leadership as well as some mature freshman. The hope is that next year Em-Power town will be a 4 day event, similar to Anytown.
